US News and World Report Gives The Kenney a 5-Star Rating

SEATTLE, Wash. -- U.S. News and World Report magazine gives West Seattle's The Kenney skilled nursing facility a 5-Star rating in its national review of similar facilities. Rated in the top tier among 15,500 facilities across the country, the Kenney is one of only 27 that received the 5-Star rating. The skilled nursing facility, with a capacity of 20 residents, is an important part of West Seattle's only Continuing Care Retirement Community (CCRC) which has 185 residents. The U.S. News and World Report ratings of nursing facilities are based in part on data and ratings found on [Nursing Home Compare](#), a federal website created by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). The magazine combines these data with additional measures of excellence to create its rankings.

"This recognition means a great deal to us," said The Kenney's President and CEO Kevin McFeely, "because it's an external measure of our commitment to excellence, which is consistent throughout The Kenney community."

The Kenney was founded more than a century ago in the Fauntleroy neighborhood of West Seattle by pioneers Samuel and Jessie Kenney. As a CCRC, it offers retirees a spectrum of lifestyle options from independent living apartments, to assisted living-type residences to skilled nursing and respite care. This allows residents to stay within the same community as their lifestyle needs change over time.

The Kenney is a not-for-profit organization affiliated with the Presbyterian Church that welcomes residents of all faiths.
